### Greetings!

On this first day of Spring we remember and celebrate fathers and father figures. Some us have [or have had] wonderful fathers. Some of us might have had challenging relationships with our father and some may be grieving those who fathered them. Fathers have a very important job. They are VIPs. Personally I always thought that becoming a parent helped me grow up [somewhat..]! Let's remember all fathers, and those who grieve their relationships with their fathers in our prayers this month. And take the time to encourage the fathers you know or come across.

It's taken me a while.and I'm still learning.. to get to know God; our Heavenly Father. While us humans tend to make mistakes left, right and centre, God never mucks up - he is always the perfect parent, who loves us unconditionally! This is pretty hard to wrap our heads around. 
